Arrival Time:

Morning arrival cut-off time is 9:00 am. (this excludes infants and Ms. Dexter's class) After 9:00 a.m. your child will be considered tardy. After 3 tardies your child must stay home for the day, but can return the next school day. Tardy slips will be given. **Please remember your child must enter and exit with an adult ONLY (18 years of age and older).**

Uniforms:

Please make sure that you are dressing your children appropriately. If your child will be wearing a jacket throughout the day, **IT MUST BE NAVY BLUE.** Jackets should be labeled. Please return any jackets that you may take home by mistake.

Needed Items for Infant & Nursery

Parents, please remember to bring baby wipes, diapers, and an extra set of clothing for your children. Extra items will eliminate the phone calls to you during your work schedule. We still need tissue for your little ones. We only had about 20% of parents that brought tissue, **DON'T FORGET!!!!!!**

Tuition:

Tuition payment is due each Monday of the week. A late fee will be assessed to your account if tuition is not paid by Tuesday afternoon. Also, remember a \$25.00 late fee will be charged to your account if your child exceeds the 9 hour daily care allowance per day. No credit on tuition is given for illness, holidays or vacations. All balances should be \$0.00 on December 31st. We will not take 2011 balances into 2012. The books for 2011 will be closed at the end of the year. Make sure you make your payments on or before December 31st. The facility will be open, so there are no excuses in getting your payments in. If there is a balance left on your account, your child/children will not be able to attend the daycare in January 2012 until payments are paid in FULL.
